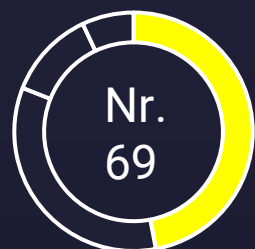

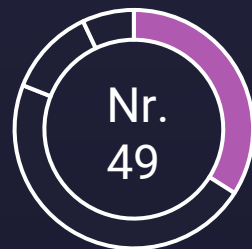

Does Economic Council continue to be seen as a non-partisan private public dialogue platform?



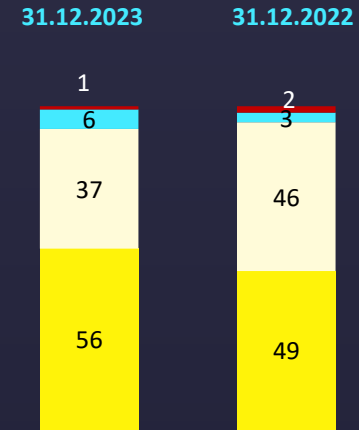
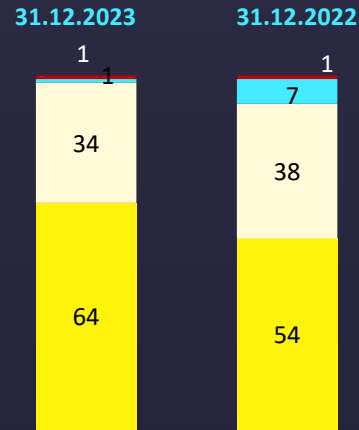
The results achieved by the Economic Council contribute to the increasing popularity of the platform among the business community.



Economic Council promotes initiatives that correspond to the interests of business associations and good international practices.

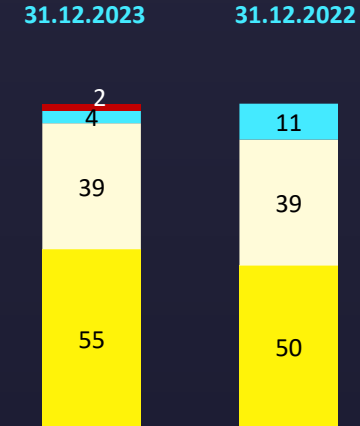
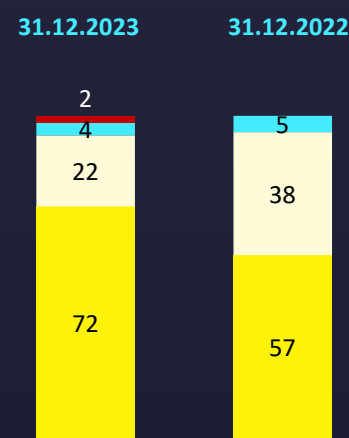
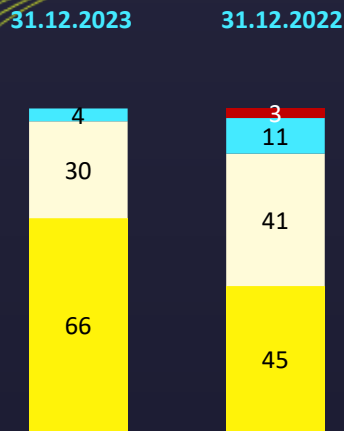

The interaction between the Secretariat of the Economic Council with the decision-makers in the Government allows a better implementation of the reforms



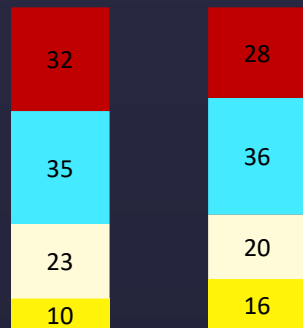
The Economic Council promotes reforms and initiatives that help strengthen women's empowerment in business.

The Economic Council ensures an effective dialogue between the Government institutions and the Small and Medium Enterprises community in order to address the issues raised by SMEs.

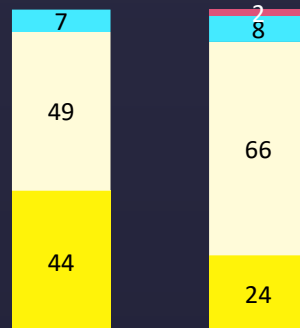

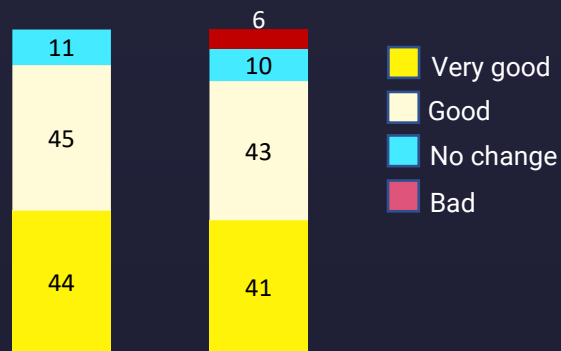
The non-representation of the business community in the EC generates accusations of partisanship.

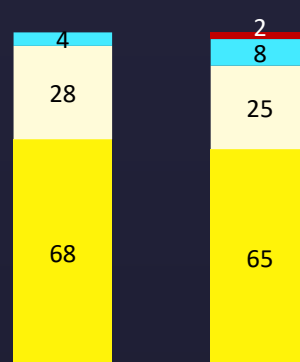
Has the business environment improved in the areas the Economic Council have undertaken its work?
